Regulate Air Toxins

HB22-1244

- Colorado needs a state-level Air Toxins Program to meaningfully reduce toxic pollution and protect community health
- This Bill will empower the CO Dept. of Public Health and Environment to study and set health-based standards for air quality



Ozone Monitoring

- Colorado has a severe Ozone pollution problem that we are under-equipped to address with current technology
- This Bill would improve Ozone monitoring and modeling practices in Colorado, giving us the tools to improve air quality

Immigration Reform

Cover All Coloradans

- This Bill will provide full health care coverage for pregnant people who would otherwise be eligible for assistance if not for their immigration status, and continues coverage through 12 months postpartum
- This Bill also provides full health care coverage to children, regardless of immigration status, so that all children can access the healthcare they need
